SUMMARY OF POSITION:

The Materials Handler is responsible for the movement, storage, and distribution of materials in the warehouse. This role ensures materials are received, organized, and distributed efficiently to support operations.

Key Responsibilities:

- 1. Accept, inspect, and verify incoming goods.
- 2. Properly store materials in designated areas, ensuring easy accessibility.
- Set up and maintain the five vocational stations.1) baling, 2) incoming clothes, 3) sorting canned goods,
 4) sorting Amazon goods and bulk mailing, and 5) assisting drivers with pick-ups. There will be no driving.
- 4. Train vocational students in areas including but not limited to the five vocational stations. There will be no driving.
- 5. Retrieve and prepare goods for distribution.
- 6. Operate forklifts, pallet jacks, or other equipment to move materials safely.
- 7. Follow workplace safety guidelines, handle materials correctly, and maintain a clean work area.
- 8. Work collaboratively with BARM leadership and staff to advance BARM's ministry; attend all required meetings, including program meetings, staff meetings, and other meetings as requested.

SKILLS & QUALIFICATIONS:

- 1. Committed Christian, interested and willing to work with homeless, addicted, mentally ill and impoverished, able to share the Gospel through words and actions.
- 2. Knowledgeable in warehouse/distribution center operations, shipping/receiving, storage, and inventory control.
- 3. Honest, trustworthy, adaptable, and conscientious.
- 4. Good team player who is able and willing to perform functions while honoring BARM core values and working collaboratively with staff, volunteers, and residents.
- 5. Good interpersonal skills, interacting courteously and clearly with donors.
- 6. Able to problem solve and process analytically.
- 7. Able to manage time effectively to fulfill duties.
- 8. Able to perform in a fast-paced environment while treating people with courtesy, respect and sensitivity
- 9. Previous forklift operation desired
- 10. Able to read, write, and perform basic mathematical computations
- 11. High school diploma or equivalent (preferred).
- 12. Previous experience in warehousing, logistics, or material handling (a plus).
- 13. Ability to lift and move heavy objects (50+ lbs).
- 14. Familiarity with inventory systems and basic computer skills.
- 15. Forklift certification (preferred but not always required).
- 16. Strong attention to detail and organizational skills.
- 17. Ability to work independently and as part of a team.

WORKING CONDITIONS/PHYSICAL FACTORS:

- Occasionally = 1%-33%; Frequently = 34%-66%; Continuously = 67%-100%
 - 1. Stand on hard surfaces for extended periods continuously



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- 2. Able to lift up to 50 lbs *frequently*
- 3. Requires regular interaction with homeless, impoverished, and mentally ill individuals continuously
- 4. Exposed to dust, odors, noise and fumes continuously
- 5. Climb stairs Occasionally
- 6. Sitting, standing, climbing, bending, lifting, reaching, walking continuously on a rotating basis
- 7. Good manual dexterity and fine motor skills continuously
